**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with the Taranaki Mountain Airs in New Zealand in the summer of 2007, averaging a league-high 26.2 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 2.6 assists in 18 games. With the Airs in the summer of 2006, averaged 24.1 points and 3.6 rebounds in 11 games. Started the summer of 2006 in Venezuela Played briefly with Guaiqueries de Margarita, averaging 10.7 points in three games. Played with the Roanoke Dazzle in the NBA Developmental League in 2004-05, averaging 13.6 points and 2.6 rebounds in 14 games.

**College Career Highlights:** Finished collegiate career as Nevada's eighth all-time scoring leader with 1,340 points. Also ranks second in career free throws made (437) and set the record for career free throws attempted (624). Started 105 of 124 career games.

**Senior (2003-04):** Averaged 9.8 points and 3.6 rebounds. Started 33 of 34 games. Scored in double figures 17 times, with a season-high 18 points twice, vs. Toledo and San Jose State. Tallied 16 points on 6-for-8 shooting vs. Rice. Recorded ten points and five assists vs. Gonzaga in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Named to the WAC All-Defensive Team.

**Junior (2002-03):** Averaged 10.6 points and 4.6 rebounds. Ranked third on the team in scoring and rebounding. Started all 32 games. Scored in double figures 19 times. Posted season-high 26 points vs. Fresno State. Registered 24 points on 8-for-11 shooting at Santa Clara. Scored 13 points and grabbed a career-high nine rebounds vs. Boise State.

**Sophomore (2001-02):** Averaged 15.6 points (eighth in the WAC) and 3.8 rebounds. Ranked fifth in the WAC in field goal percentage (.468). Started all 30 games. Posted 20 or more points in nine games, with a career-high 30 points vs. Portland State. Notched 28 points including a perfect 10-for-10 free throw shooting vs. Boise State. Dished out a career-high seven assists vs. Rice. Scored 26 points and tied a school record for free attempts with 20 at Cal State Northridge in the season opener.

**Freshman (2000-01):** Averaged 7.2 points and 2.2 rebounds. Started ten times. Recorded double figure scoring in nine of his last 11 games. Registered season-high 19 points vs. Fresno State. Scored 16 points at Hawaii. Led team with 15 points vs. Rice in the first round of the WAC Tournament.
